Martha Hewett has nearly 30 years of experience in energy efficiency and indoor air quality in commercial and multifamily buildings. Her work has focused on field research, retro-commissioning technology and market assessments.

Ms. Hewett is currently Director of Research at the Center for Energy and Environment (CEE). Her research has several studies of contaminant transfer between apartments and occupant perceptions of air quality in multifamily buildings, and of current practices in design for infection control in hospitals, as well as numerous studies on the real-world performance of energy efficiency measures. Ms. Hewett led CEE's retro-commissioning team for 10 years, achieving highly cost-effective energy savings and improvements in ventilation and thermal comfort in high-rise office towers, schools, hospitals and theaters. She has published extensively in peer-reviewed conference proceedings and the archival literature on building science.

Ms. Hewett is currently Chair of ASHRAE's Research Administration Committee and has served as chair of ASHRAE's Standards Committee. She holds an M.S. degree from the University of Minnesota and an A.B. degree from Middlebury College.
