45-Day Public Review from December 2, 2011, to January 16, 2012

- ♦ **3rd Public Review of BSR/ASHRAE Standard 147-2002R, *Reducing the Release of Halogenated Refrigerants from Air-Conditioning Equipment and Systems***

This revision of Standard 147 updates the 2002 edition by expanding the number of equipment types and systems covered, by providing significant requirements for field-erected systems, by adding more sections on leak checking, by adding requirements for systems with larger charges, by addressing the shipping and handling of containers for refrigerants, and by making many formerly recommended practices mandatory.

ANNOUNCEMENT

BSR/ASHRAE Standard 189.2, *Design, Construction and Operation of Sustainable High Performance Health Care Facilities*, has been renumbered to Standard 189.3, effective immediately. The 189.2 number will be saved for a potential high performance residential standard.
